PREMATURE TERMINATION OF THE TOURNAMENT BROUGHT ABOUT BY WAR, NATURAL EMERGENCY, OR EMERGENCY CAUSES RELATING THERETO OR THEREFROM FIRES, STRIKES, LABOR DIFFICULTIES OR OTHER REASONS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE OHIO WOMEN'S INTER-CITY BOWLING TOURNAMENT SHALL CAUSE THE PRIZE LIST TO BE PRORATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NUMBER OF ENTRANTS WHO HAVE BOWLED IN EACH OF THE RESPECTIVE EVENTS UP TO THE TIME OF TERMINATION.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament open to all women whose USBC membership is paid through a league sanction in Ohio cities of under 75,000 population. MEMBERSHIP WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE LEAGUE LOCATION WHERE YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD WAS PURCHASED. Unmarried grade and high school students under 18 years of age must furnish written consent signed by a parent or guardian. See General Playing Rule 13. Ohio USBC Youth average is acceptable. USBC members of leagues from Akron, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, Dayton, Toledo and Youngstown are ineligible.
2. Handicap 90% of 225 scratch in Team, Doubles, Singles and Handicap All Events.
3. All averages must be verified by the Local Association Manager. The highest final average of each bowler must be used. Average based on any USBC sanctioned league in which a bowler has bowled 21 games or more as a regular or substitute during the 19-20 season. If no previous winter average, an entrant shall use her highest current USBC sanctioned average as of 12 games or more by the time she bowls. Summer league averages will be used only if bowler has no acceptable 19-20 or current average. Sport averages may not be used. Please present verification of these averages during check-in. Any bowler not meeting the average requirements will bowl scratch average 225. All winners' averages are subject to verification by the Local Association Manager.
4. USBC Rule 319c – there will be no re-rating of average. USBC Rule 319a2 – the ten pin or higher rule does not apply. USBC Rule 319a3 will apply. Team or individuals may be disqualified for submitting incorrect average or for any violation of tournament rules by the team or any member of the team. USBC Rule 319d will not apply. Tournament prize winnings for the previous year need not be reported. USBC Rule 319e will not apply. Average adjustment for entry.
5. Awards will be given to the winners in Handicap and Scratch Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events. If an individual or team wins both the handicap and scratch titles, she/they will be awarded only the scratch awards. The handicap awards will be given to the second place team/individual. In case of a tie, duplicate awards will be presented. Team Awards: 1 actual and 1 handicap. Awards will be given for high game and series, actual and handicap in any event. Entrants eligible for only one award.
6. Prize money will be given for scores with handicap. All Events is optional and the entry fee for this handicap event is \$ 3.00 per person and \$ 5.00 for actual entered prior to entry deadline. Scratch scores with handicap scores will count for prizes in the All Events. If an individual who has not paid the optional All Events fee bowls the actual high All Events score, she will be declared the All Events Champion and will be given the award but will receive no prize money. You may enter one or both All Events. First score bowled will be used to figure All Events total.
7. Prize fee to be returned 100%. Ratio of return to be 1 out of 5 in team, doubles and singles. All Events actual and handicap ration will be 1 out of 10.
8. **IMPORTANT: REQUESTS TO CROSS LANES WILL BE MADE BY MUTUAL CONSENT OF BOTH TEAMS AND WILL BE GRANTED WHENEVER POSSIBLE. THE SPACE ON THE ENTRY FORM PROVIDED FOR SUCH REQUESTS MUST BE COMPLETED BY BOTH CAPTAINS AND ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SENT TOGETHER IN THE SAME ENVELOPE.**
9. Reservations will be accepted until September 30, 2020. Reserved entry and complete fees must be postmarked by November 15, 2020 or the reservation will be automatically cancelled. Additional squads will be opened only when stated dates and times are filled. Entries from the Host City will be last to fill in squads.
10. Entries close December 15, 2020 (midnight). All entries postmarked the first post office business day following December 15, 2020 will be accepted.
11. Total entry fees must be sent with completed entry form. Personal checks will be accepted. A \$ 30.00 service charge will be made for checks returned by the bank. No entry money will be returned for any reason once the schedule and prize list has been printed.
12. **EACH ENTRANT IS PERMITTED TO BOWL (AS A REGULAR OR SUB) NO MORE THAN "TWICE" IN TEAM (MUST CHANGE AT LEAST "TWO" MEMBERS) OR DOUBLES (MUST CHANGE PARTNERS) AND SINGLES. SINGLES CAN ONLY CASH ONCE.**
13. Bowler has option to bowl Doubles and/or Singles.
14. No change in schedule will be made after schedule has been completed, except in case of emergency. The President and/or Secretary will rule as to emergency. No entry will be refunded after prize list is prepared.
15. Team captains must report to the tournament office one hour before scheduled time of bowling, present membership cards for each bowler and verify all members present. Doubles Partners must check in one hour before scheduled time and present membership cards.
16. Substitutes will be permitted and must report one hour before scheduled time of bowling. Subs must bowl in the position vacated by the original entrant, No rearranging of team lineups or double partners will be permitted. However, if a replacement is needed on each of two doubles teams, the two entrants present may be paired together. No entrant shall be permitted to change her position in any team or of two doubles teams after she has been checked onto the lanes to bowl. Violation may be cause for disqualification, refer to Rule 5 for All Events. Refer to Rule 3 for average. Verification of average must be presented to the tournament manager at both houses. A substitute may participate in any event. No substitution can be made in the singles event after the series has started. No pacers are allowed in this tournament.
17. Any entrant arriving late will be permitted to bowl and shall begin play with her score to count beginning with the frame being bowled. If an entrant is late for the doubles event, the Entrant present will bowl her singles event first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is finished and a substitute cannot be found, she will be permitted to bowl her games in the doubles event so she can qualify for all events. Bowling frames lost may not be made up and no pins allowed for lost frames. You must be ready when it is your turn to bowl.
18. In case of injury after a series has started in team or doubles, a substitute will be permitted, if one is immediately available. Handicap will be figured on the higher average of the two Bowlers involved, with frames already bowled to count. If a substitute is not available, actual scores of the disabled bowler will count for the frames bowled.
19. An obvious error in scoring must be reported to the tournament office within 24 hours.
20. Protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be filed in writing to the tournament secretary before tournament prize payments are made.
21. Bowling balls must meet USBC specifications.
22. Bowlers are not permitted to open practice bowl on the tournament lanes on the days they are scheduled in the tournament.
23. Bowlers are expected to wear suitable attire for participation in OWICBT. Examples of prohibited attire include: tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, workout attire, short shorts, short skirts, short culottes, bib overalls and cutoffs. The length of items (shorts, skirts, culottes) must go beyond fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management. Tournament management's decision will be final.
24. All bowling etiquette must be observed when bowling and will be strictly enforced. Only one lane on each side of bowler need be open when bowlers' turn comes up.
